This advance release is a regular publication of Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS). It presents the data on industrial production of selected industries on monthly basis as well as includes the indices of medium and large-scale manufacturing industries. The production index is the most important business indicator, which aims to measure the trend of industrial production during the long period of time.

To assess the movement of industrial production, data are collected from state owned manufacturing enterprises (SOEs) and major manufacturing enterprises in the private sector on monthly basis. BBS always monitors monthly production data.

I hope and believe that this publication will be a very useful to the policy makers, researchers and concerned agencies. Comments and suggestions for further improvement of this report will be highly appreciated.

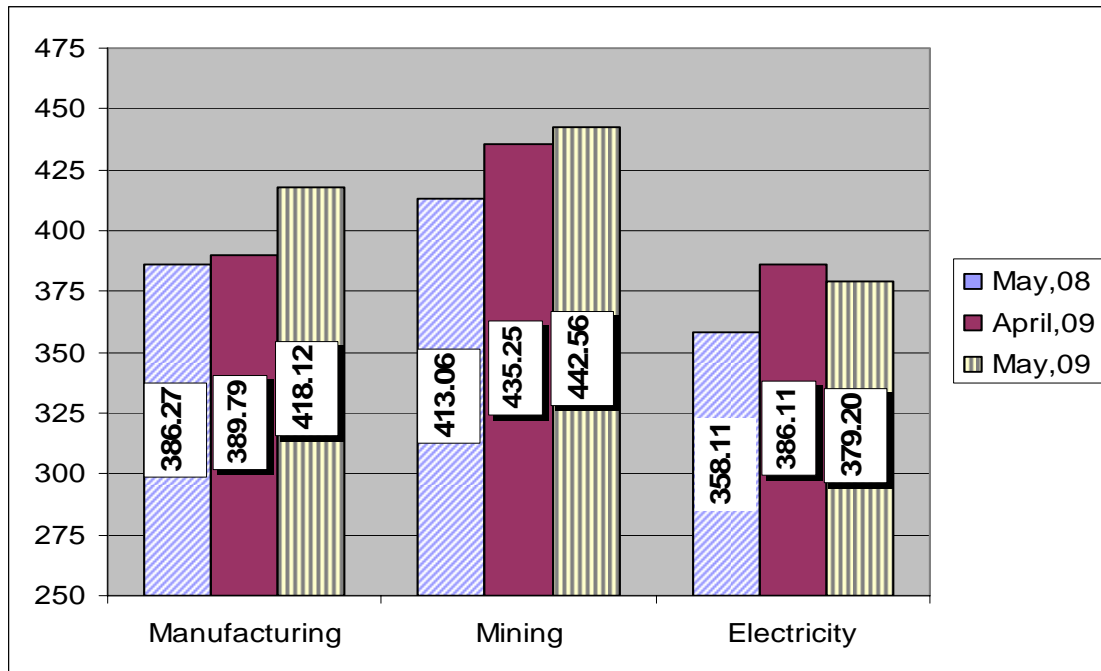
